Spotlight on Gabby Zematis

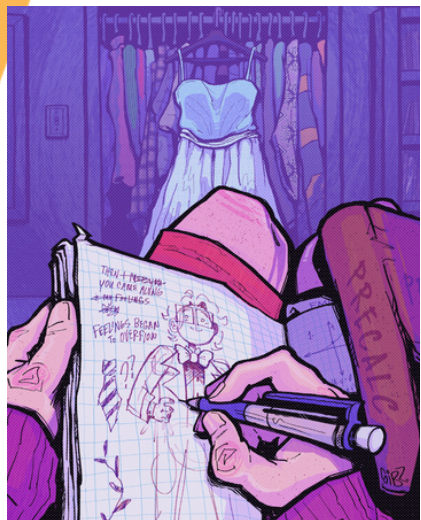

She has a BFA in illustration and a concentration in creative writing from the Cleveland Institute of Art, and credits coming-of-age in fandom spaces online for sparking her interest in art. Currently, Gabby has two projects in progress: a graphic memoir titled, *Hard Cheese*, and a Greek mythology-inspired novel she hopes to share soon. She can often be found exhibiting at comic and art fairs.



"I first found *The Prom* in 2017 and was immediately drawn to its story of a teenage girl who wants to take her girlfriend to prom. As a newer theater fan, I had not yet found a show that felt so personal, joyful, and necessary. I followed its journey to Broadway, saw it before it closed, and since then have sought out local productions whenever I can. What keeps bringing me back is not just the show itself, but the audience: each time, I wait to see how people will respond, and each time they laugh, connect, and open their hearts. For me, *The Prom* is more than a musical - it is a safe space. I hope it feels that way for everyone in the room: for the cast and crew, for young people who need to see themselves onstage, and for anyone still learning how love, humor, and empathy can bridge divides." - Gabby Zematis

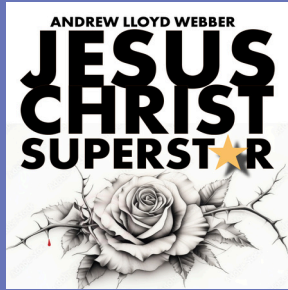

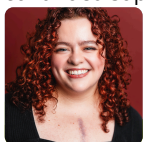
Who's Who in the Cast

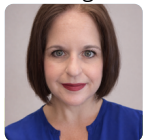

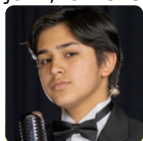

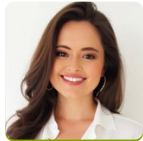

family and friends!



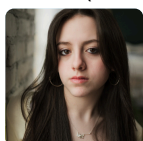
