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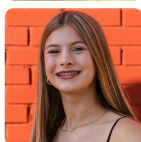
Who's Who in the Cast

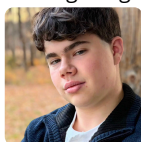

wonderful show and he would like to thank his parents and all his directors who make his dreams possible.



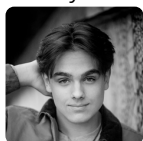
